Coronavirus COVID-19 Action Plan:

(approved by the CPGRR, Inc. Board of Directors 19 August 2020)

CPGRR, Inc. has adopted the Policy to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and encourages all members to take additional precautions with compliance to this policy. Effective immediately we are requiring all members to frequently wash one's hands and to regularly clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces to prevent COVID-19 spread. We recognize that railroad facilities, equipment and trains represent a special challenge as they are most often used as shared resources. As with all other surfaces you encounter, it is impossible to be positive that COVID19 is not present and the potential for COVID19 exposure exists after each use.

Therefore, we believe it is in everyone's best interest to frequently clean the equipment and facilities used; especially after they are used by others for maintenance activities or events.

CPGRR Members

1. All CPGRR members will keep six feet apart when involved with any railroad activities, maintaining social distancing requirements. **All CPGRR members will wear face masks** when social distancing is required. All engineers, conductors and other persons involved with railroad activities such as running/hauling the public will wear face masks:
 - a. **Cloth face coverings** must meet CDC design specifications to:
 - i. Fit snugly but comfortably against the side of the face,
 - ii. Completely cover the nose and mouth,
 - iii. Be secured with ties or ear loops,
 - iv. Include multiple layers of fabric,
 - v. Allow for breathing without restriction, and
 - vi. Be able to be laundered and machine dried without damage or change to shape.
 - vii. Masks with exhalation valves or vents will NOT be worn.
 - b. **Reusable face coverings** should be frequently washed at a minimum once per day. Single use coverings should be properly discarded into trash receptacles.
 - c. Based on guidance from health authorities, at this time, neck gaiters, open-chin triangle bandanas, and face coverings containing valves, mesh material or holes

of any kind (including masks with exhaust ventilation ports) are not acceptable face coverings.

2. All engineers, conductors and train crews will wear gloves and/or wash/sanitize hands after each trip when hauling the public. Cleaning stations will be at train depot.
3. CPGRR members -Hand washing is an essential method for avoiding the COVID-19 virus.
 - a. Frequently wash hands with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds.
 - b. If soap and warm water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
 - c. Cleaning stations will be at train depot when hauling the public.
4. All confirmed cases of COVID19 they will be reported to a CPGRR Officer or Director following identification or disclosure of the case.

General Public

1. When the public is standing in line there will be spacing at least six feet apart, and well-marked.
2. All passengers will wear face masks when riding the train and will be spaced six feet apart, maintaining social distancing requirements. *An exception is when passengers are from the same household they may sit on the same car.*
3. The CPGRR, Inc. assumption of risk form will be signed by all riders and signed by the parents for children.

Rolling Stock, Riding Cars, and Facilities

1. All train cars will be cleaned by the train crew after each run when hauling the public.
2. At the end of the day, all train cars will be cleaned by the train crew and properly stored for next run.

3. The frequency of cleaning and disinfecting facilities will increase, focusing on high-touch surfaces, meeting rooms, Carolwood museum, the club restroom, faucets, doorknobs, shared tools, and radios.
4. The following solutions are used for disinfection of hard, non-porous surfaces:
 - a. **A 10% diluted bleach solution**, an **alcohol solution with at least 70% alcohol**, and/or an EPA-registered disinfectant for use against COVID19.
 - i. Prepare a 10% diluted bleach solution by doing the following:
 - Mix five tablespoons of bleach per gallon of water.
 - After application, allow 2 minutes of contact time before wiping, or allow to air dry (without wiping).
 - b. **Peroxiclean** – Commercially available hydrogen peroxide is a stable and effective disinfectant when used on inanimate surfaces.
 - i. This EPA registered product quickly disinfects in 3-5 minutes.
 - ii. After application, allow 5 minutes of contact time before wiping, or allow to air dry (without wiping).
