are not experiencing any of the following symptoms of COVID-19 identified by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention at CDC.gov, including:

- a. Fever or chills
- b. Cough
- c. Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- d. Fatigue
- e. Muscle or body aches
- f. Headache
- g. New loss of taste or smell
- h. Sore throat
- i. Congestion or runny nose
- j. Nausea or vomiting
- k. Diarrhea
- l. have not been in contact with someone with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 symptoms without completing a 14-day quarantine

m. are not under any self-quarantine orders

Guests who cannot confirm all the above criteria must not enter Central Pasco and Gulf Railroad.

By entering Central Pasco and Gulf Railroad, you acknowledge that you understand and will abide by the above health-and-safety requirements.

Face Masks

Cloth face coverings must meet CDC design specifications to:

- a. Fit snugly but comfortably against the side of the face
- b. Completely cover the nose and mouth
- c. Be secured with ties or ear loops
- d. Include multiple layers of fabric
- e. Allow for breathing without restriction
- f. Be able to be laundered and machine dried without damage or change to shape
- g. iii. Type of face coverings shall be determined by the Contractor
- h. iv. Reusable face coverings should be frequently washed at a minimum once per day
- i. v. Single use coverings should be properly discarded into trash receptacles
- j. vi. Based on guidance from health authorities, at this time, neck gaiters, open-chin triangle
- k. bandanas, and face coverings containing valves, mesh material or holes of any kind are not acceptable face coverings.
